
I'M NOT CRYING, YOU ARE...



- Breed: Husky/mix
- Age: 9 years old
- Weight: 48.8 lbs

FOSTER NEEDS:

We have recently discovered Loki has cutaneous epitheliotropic lymphoma (form of skin cancer that can form nodules around lips, eyelids and nose). He is looking for an end of life foster that will monitor his food and water intake, take him on short walks with no excessive activity, and give him medication twice a day for his Valley Fever. He will also be needing to be transported to the shelter for check ups when needed.

Second and third, are a bonded pair; Clancy and Suzi Q.



ABOUT CLANCY:

- Breed: Australian Cattle dog/mix
- Age: 5 years old
- Weight: 75.4 lbs

FOSTER NEEDS:

Clancy has an ACL injury on his right hind leg and is looking for a foster home that will help him with monitored care, love, and limit his activity. He will be needing surgery and will need his foster home help him recover from that surgery, administer medications, and assist with physical therapy.

ABOUT SUZI Q:

- Breed: Pointer/mix
- Age: 7 years old
- Weight: 57 lbs

FOSTER NEEDS:

Suzi and Clancy came in together and have been inseparable ever since. They're a bonded pair and will need to be fostered together. When they're apart, they both struggle without their other half. It's clear their hearts are happiest when they're side by side.

CAN RECYCLING AND DOG BANKS

An update on our can recycling and dog bank revenue. Both programs are doing wonderful and we thank everyone for their participation.

For our fiscal year (July 2024-June 2025) earnings:

- **Can recycling:** \$19,864.60
- **Dog banks:** \$3,359.73

Please note: this is the only drop-off location that benefits HSCAZ - (We no longer have drop-off bins in Pine or Strawberry).

Last fiscal year (July 2024 - June 2025), our can recycling program brought in \$19,864.60 to help support the cats and dogs we care for in the shelter.

FREQUENT Q & A

Q: Do you microchip pets?

A: Yes we do. We offer microchipping Tuesday through Saturday from 9:30 to 3:30pm for only \$25.00. We only ask that you call before coming in to make sure we have staff available to administer the microchip. Also, HSCAZ occasionally holds microchip clinics where we offer microchipping at a reduced rate. All microchips given by HSCAZ will also be registered in the pet owner's name.

Q: Do you need volunteers?

A: Yes, we'd love your help! Volunteers are always welcome at both our shelter and resale store. Stop by either location to pick up an application. There are plenty of areas you can lend a hand in and make a difference!

Q: Can I complete my community service hours with HSCAZ?

A: Yes, however there are some offences that we will not accept. You may come into the shelter at 605 W Wilson Ct to pick up an application.

Q: I'm having a hard time feeding my pets. Are you able to help?

A: Yes! We can absolutely help. HSCAZ offers the following assistance:

- The Feeding Fido Program. This program provides a monthly supply of pet food to qualifying families. Feeding Fido applications are available at the HSCAZ shelter, located at 605 W. Wilson Ct. in Payson, Arizona. Applications are also available at the CAP office and at DES in Payson, AZ.
- One-time emergency food pick up. This program is perfect for those that are needing one-time assistance to get by until their next payday, etc. All you need to do is come in during business hours with a picture ID. Please note that the emergency pickup can only be used once per year.

Also please be aware that the food that is distributed for both the Feeding Fido Program or one-time assistance is 100% donated by the public and you will not be able to request a specific brand. HSCAZ office hours are Tuesday through Saturday from 9:30am to 3:30pm.

Q: What kind of donations do you take?

A: HSCAZ will be happy to accept any animal related items such as; gently used leashes and collars, food and water bowls, pet carriers/crates, etc. HSCAZ will also be glad to accept old blankets, towels, sheets, pillowcases, etc. Pet food and treats of any kind will also be greatly appreciated, even open bags/containers are acceptable. If you have any questions about what to donate you may call us at (928) 474-5590.

MICROCHIPS

A microchip is one of the most reliable ways to ensure your pet can be returned to you if they ever become lost. Unlike collars or tags that can fall off, a microchip is a permanent form of identification that stays with your pet for life.

But here's the key: a microchip is only as effective as the information linked to it. If your phone number, address, or email changes, be sure to update your pet's microchip registration. Without current information, shelters and veterinary clinics may not be able to reach you when your pet is found.

Taking a few minutes to verify and update your pet's microchip details could be the difference between a quick reunion and a long, stressful search.

Take action today: Check your pet's microchip and make sure your information is up to date!

Don't have a microchip? HSCAZ offers microchipping for only \$25 on Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday from 10am - 3pm as long as we have medical staff available.
